## Annual sale of hyacinths



We were looking forward to our annual sale of pots of hyacinth bulbs at the Farmer's Market on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> November – but sadly the exceptionally wet and windy weather meant the Market had to be cancelled.

However, you'll find us at the **Christmas Market in Falkland Square on November 30**<sup>th</sup> and we're planning to pop up in the **George Precinct** now and again. Three to a pot, the hyacinths come in pink, blue or white. As the photo on the right shows, you can plant them in the garden to flower again the following year – or more.
